Specific Rules and Regulations for Division R - Crafts and Hobbies:

1. All entries must be the original work of the exhibitor.
2. If the exhibitor wishes to sell the entry, attach a small card stating FOR SALE with the price of the entry. It may be picked up by the purchaser ONLY after the exhibit closes on Sunday, July 13, 2008.
3. Definitions of amateur and professional:
AMATEUR: A person who pursues art as a hobby or vocation. This does not exclude those who may sell their work occasionally.
PROFESSIONAL: A person who earns his/her livelihood in the arts, a designer, or person who teaches or supervises art programs.
4. Any exhibit not included in the following categories will be accepted but will not be considered for judging. No lots will be added at the time of entry to accommodate unspecified exhibits.
5. **NOTE:** "Class ?" is included with Crafts and Hobbies. This class is for the unknown item. Identification may be written on a small card for display purposes. The items may be antique, of foreign country origin, etc.
6. Any entry exhibited in a previous year at the Winona County Fair will not be accepted.
7. All exhibits must be arranged for display in a suitable case, container or frame.
NO LOOSE OBJECTS WILL BE ACCEPTED.
