Only one entry fee is required for all Open Class Exhibits (this includes Fine Arts and Photography). However - ***exhibits in Fine Arts and Photography should be brought directly to the Arts Building (Rentfrow Hall) for entry.***

### **RULES AND REGULATIONS:**

1. All entries ***MUST*** be the original work of the exhibitor.
2. Work shown at the Winona County Fair previously will not be accepted.
3. **All hanging entries must be framed or matted and have a picture wire or secure loop for hanging. No saw tooth hangers or cardboard hangers. Pieces not properly equipped will not be accepted.!**
4. No oil paintings will be accepted if not dry. Pastels and other works which can be easily damaged must be covered by glass or clear plastic.
5. Each work must carry a small card on the back or base, indicating the artists name, address, title of work and an indication as to whether the work is for sale or not and the price.

6. **An exhibitor may only register in one class such as a youth, amateur, professional or senior citizen and within that class may submit 2 entries per lot.**
7. Judging will take place Tuesday, July 8, 2008. The building is not open to the public during this time. The judge will award 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> place in each lot, Grand and Reserve Champion in each class and an overall Grand and Reserve Best of Show. The right to withhold awards is reserved if, in the judge's opinion, work submitted does not justify an award. Merit and Honorable Mention ribbons will be given at the discretion of the judge.
9. ***Articles may only be picked up after the exhibit closes at 8:00 pm on Sunday, July 13, 2008. Any exhibit removed prior to this will forfeit both the ribbon and cash premium.*** Your premium check can be picked up in front of Rentfrow Hall/Calico Cow building when you pick up your exhibit on Sunday evening.

**PROFESSIONAL:** A person who earns his/her livelihood in the art field. This includes commercial artists, designers and those persons who teach or supervise art programs or shows his/her work in a gallery.

3. **Photographs must be no smaller than 4X6.**
4. **Photographs must be securely framed or matted and ready to be hung with wire. No sawtooth hangers or cardboard hangers. Pieces not properly equipped will not be accepted!**
5. All prints must have the entrant's name, address, title of work, class and lot numbers on the back lower right corner.
6. **An exhibitor may only register in one class such as a youth, amateur, professional or senior citizen and within that class may submit 2 entries per lot**
7. Judging will take place Tuesday, July 8, 2008. The building is not open to the public during this time. The judge will award the following: 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> place

in each lot, Grand and Reserve Champion in each class and an overall Grand and Reserve Best of Show. The right to withhold awards is reserved if, in the judge's opinion, work submitted does not justify an award. Merit and Honorable Mention ribbons will be given at the discretion of the judge.
